
How to Dispose of Outdated Appliances

Attempting to disassemble the appliance for components or other purposes is not recommended.


Larger appliances may include potentially hazardous elements or toxic foam insulation.

SELL OR GIVE



If the item is still in working order or can be fixed, there is someone out there who would want to purchase it from you. Offer the appliance for sale or make it available for free pick-up to anybody who wants it.

REMOVING THE OLD APPLIANCE FROM THE BUNDLE



When you buy a new washer or dryer from a store, you may be able to have the old one taken away as an option. You should look for stores that offer a deal where you get a free removal as part of your upgrade.

CONTACTING A JUNK REMOVAL SERVICE



Call your local debris removal company, landfill, or garbage aprofessionals and inquire about pick-up service options. Keep in mind that if you're asking how to get rid of a certain equipment, be precise.

TRASH COLLECTOR



Find out if your town has a trash service by looking up their website. You can see what services they offer and how to get rid of a refrigerator or other old things this way.

TO GET RID OF THINGS, RENT A DUMPSTER



Rent a dumpster for your old appliances and other rubbish.

Consider this option if you're getting rid of your appliance as part of a larger renovation job that includes a lot of construction trash.
